

SECTION 1 FIRE DEPARTMENT ORGANIZATION

The Certification Board suggests it will take a class of **40** individuals **16** hours to cover the following objectives in this section (actual time may vary based on class size).

BASIC

- 1-01.01* Trainee shall identify the organization of the fire department.
- 1-01.02* Trainee shall identify the size of the fire department, the scope of its operation, and the Standard Operational Procedures (SOPs).
- 1-01.03* Trainee shall identify the fire department rules and regulations as they apply to all members of the department.
- 1-01.04* Trainee shall define the incident command system (ICS).

Completion of ICS-100 meets the requirements of 1-01.04

INTERMEDIATE - INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM

- 1-02.01 Trainee shall list the seven (7) reasons for an ICS.
- 1-02.02 Trainee shall list the five (5) functional areas of the ICS organizational structure.
- 1-02.03 Trainee shall list the basic responsibilities of the Incident Commander.
- 1-02.04 Trainee shall define the following terms:

A. operations	C. logistics
B. planning	D. finance
- 1-02.05 Trainee shall define, demonstrate, and apply the command staff functions of an ICS system.

Completion of ICS-200 and IS-700 meets the requirements of 1-02.01 through 1-02.05
