- 20-03.01 Trainee shall identify activities on a national level required by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to meet its responsibilities to establish and maintain comprehensive and coordinated emergency management in the United States.
- 20-03.02 Trainee shall identify, by title, the official responsible for emergency management in the State of Texas.
- 20-03.03 Trainee shall identify, by title, the official responsible for emergency management in a Texas county and designated by the Texas Disaster Act as Emergency Management Director for the county.
- 20-03.04 Trainee shall identify, by title, the city official who is responsible for emergency management in a city in Texas and is designated by the Texas Disaster Act as Emergency Director for the city.
- 20-03.05 Trainee shall identify department procedures for potential disasters in the area of their response.
